Work-life balance is an important aspect of a healthy work environment. Maintaining work life balance helps reduce stress and leads to a happier and healthier life.



New Suspension Filling Line Installation

Curexa Health ensure that all manufacturing operations are strictly adhered to specific procedures that assure the highest standards of quality in manufacturing. It is especially designed to provide efficiency and compliance second to none. In this connection, new suspension filling line has been installed, with capacity ranging from 70 bottles/minute to 120 bottles/minute according to bottle size and fill weight. This machine consists of linear conveyor system, graduator, 4 head filling device, with servo motors which drives the 4 filling auger to fill with the help of graduator positioning system.

Such innovations and regular upgrades to the manufacturing facility ensure that the processes and technology are up to date with global developments.




In the month of June, Curexa Team did ever highest production. This has been possible due to relentless and persistent efforts of Production and Quality Operations team.



All the team members ensured active participation and exchanged view-points for effective selling of a new concept, followed by a team building




Physical Fitness is First Step Towards Happiness
